
7 COMMON LAYOUT LAYOUT TO AVOID





CATTLE FLOW LIKE A PRO:

7 COMMON **LAYOUT MISTAKES** TO AVOID



- → Always design based on how cattle move
- not just where the chute fits.
- UNDERESTIMATING GATE **PLACEMENT**

→ Poor gate access = poor flow and unsafe handling. Plan for people movement, too.

- **USING EQUIPMENT THAT'S TOO** → It may look good on paper — until your cattle prove
- otherwise.
- FORGETTING LOADOUT ACCESS → Make sure your loadout is easy to reach without fighting the





→ Cattle don't corner well. Use gentle curves, not hard 90s.

IGNORING GROUND CONDITIONS

> → Will it drain? Will your crew be slipping in February? Think beyond the footprint.

NOT THINKING AHEAD

→ Can you expand later? Can this system grow with your herd?
